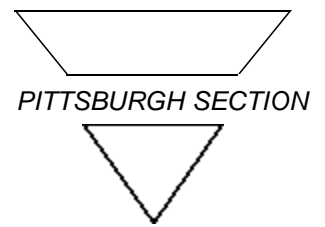


PITTSBURGH SAE INTERNATIONAL
