October 2002 has arrived and so have the new EPA mandated lower emission engines! Joe Manzione from Detroit Diesel Corporation will present a program explaining the technology that DDC is using, including EGR (exhaust gas recirculation), to meet the 2.5 grams NOX (Oxides of nitrogen) standard and the reduced particulate matter requirements. The program will be held at Penn Detroit Diesel-Allison's Cranberry branch. Penn-DDA is the distributor for Detroit Diesel engines and a division of DaimlerChrysler, Allison Transmissions, a division of General Motors, Spectrum generator sets, a division of Kohler Company, and Carrier Transicold, a division of United Technologies.
